

STAFF NEWS

As we excitedly plan for the SBC North Ridge campus launch, we've completed a thorough and honoring process to determine the staff team who will serve with us beginning in January. Every member of the current NRCC staff is quite excellent, and we have met with and prayed with each one about their role. For the few who won't be continuing with us, we have been generous with offering salary continuation and benefits. Following is a recap of the team that will carry SBC North Ridge forward beginning January 1, 2019 (Note: some titles are still a work in progress):



Kevin Yule, Campus Pastor

Kevin Yule is the current Men's and Marriage Pastor for Scottsdale Bible Church and is a gifted teacher who periodically fills in for Pastor Jamie as the weekend communicator. Kevin earned his BS in Christian Ministries from Arizona Christian University in 2001 and his MA in Biblical Leadership from Phoenix Seminary. He is continuing to work toward completing the limited remaining

requirements for his MDiv, also through Phoenix Seminary. Kevin began his ministry career as an intern at Highlands Church, in Scottsdale, AZ, before being hired as their Junior High Pastor in 2001. In 2005, Kevin assumed the role of High School Pastor at Highlands, and in 2009, was asked to oversee the entire Student Ministry department before accepting the role as their Young Adult and College Pastor in 2011. In 2013, Scottsdale Bible Church welcomed Kevin as the pastor providing vision and leadership for our Student Ministries (5th grade through college) as well as direct leadership of our High School Ministry. Then, in 2017, Kevin became our Men's and Marriage Pastor. Kevin and his wife, Brooke, have been married since 1999 and have six children: Madison (age 17), Delaney (age 15), Logan (age 13), Rylee (age 12), Caden (age 5), and McKinley (age 2).



Ryan Heath, Associate Campus Pastor

Ryan Heath is the current Children's Pastor for Scottsdale Bible Church. Ryan earned his BS in Christian Ministries with a minor in Youth Ministries from Southwestern College of the Bible (now Arizona Christian University) in 2002 and went on to earn his MA in Theological Studies from Liberty University in 2011.
